Uniform

- It is a national expectation that children fluently know up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4. Please support your child and encourage them to regularly practice these at home using TTRockstars.

Attendance

- Children should be in school everyday
- If they are unwell a message should be made to the school office via phone
- Mr Brooks or Mrs Lamb will contact you if they require further information
- Our school target is 98%+
- Holidays will not be authorised and may result in a fixed note penalty charge
- Appointments should be made outside of school time, however when this is not possible children should come into school to receive their attendance mark and then go to their appointment. If this is in the morning they should then return to school for their afternoon mark.
