Congratulations to Year who are this week's attendance champions with %. Well done children, we are all extremely proud of you. All other classes need to make a huge effort next week to improve their attendance.

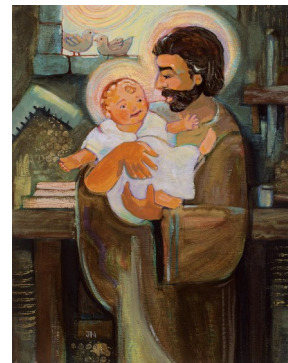
National Education Union Industrial Action
