### Attendance

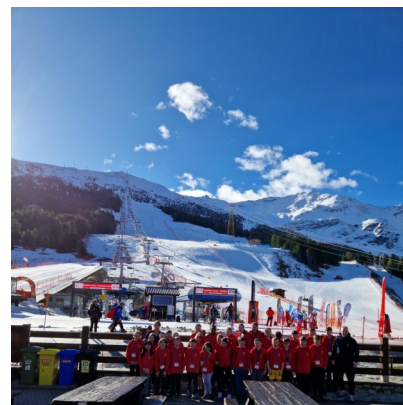
Well done to our Year 2 children for being the attendance champions of the term. The children loved their pizza party yesterday.
