### Design Technology

Electrical Systems- Simple circuits and switches- Designing and making a night light.

# **Physical Education**

Athletics- develop basic running, jumping and throwing techniques. Challenges for distance and time. speed, distance, accuracy and how to persevere to achieve their personal best.

Tennis - In this unit pupils develop the key skills required for tennis such as the ready position, racket control and forehand and backhand ground strokes, how to score points and how to use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.

Fitness- Pupils will take part in a range of fitness challenges and learn about different components of fitness.

always hot? The Sahara Desert, formation. Plants and animals in a desert. How have humans used deserts? The Patagonian Desert

Develop an understanding of musical composition, organising and manipulating ideas within musical structures and reproducing sounds from aural memory
