### Daily Routine

- As children come into class in the morning and after lunch, they use our Roar Rainbow to let me know how they are feeling.
- When children come in, the children have a number of the day task to complete. We talk through the answers together and discuss our working out using mathematical vocabulary. This is part of their basic skills work.
- On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, we go through our homework tasks as a class.
- Our timetable is visible to the whole class- they keep me in check!
- After lunch, we have independent reading- unless we can't resist reading a chapter or two of our class read! I would usually read our class book whilst the children have snack after break time.
- We use Dojo points in class and the children are awarded points for various things.
- Weekly certificates continue and are VIPs!

### Uniform

- Grey shorts or long trousers (Boys)
- Grey skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or long trousers (Girls)
- White shirt with school tie

# PE Days and Reading

- Children should attend school in their full PE kit on Wednesday. They will also be swimming on a Wednesday afternoon. Any additional lessons, I will aim to let you know well in advance via Scopay.
- We would ask that parents read with their child for 15 minutes each night and ask questions based upon the text once completed. The children have a reading record in school and must bring this home with their reading book.
- Homework will be sent out each Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and is should be retuned to school the following day. More information on the next slide!

### Year 6 Homework schedule

- Year 6 have been given homework books of short 10 minute tests to complete: Monday, Reading; Tuesday, Maths and Wednesday, Grammar.
- We will go through these as a class the following day. Please ensure that your child has the relevant book with them, this will also enable you to see your child's progress within these subjects. There will be elements of the Year 5 and 6 curriculum that have not been taught yet, please remind your child this, if they find a particular area challenging. Initially, they may need support when completing tasks and this is fine, however the aim is for them to gradually begin to work through questions independently. 10 minutes is also a guideline and to begin with, they may take longer to complete.
- Times Tables will be set on a Monday as 10 games on TTRockstars. These must be completed by the following Monday.
- Each Monday pupils will be given a **spelling** rule and spelling list which will then be set on Spelling Shed for the following Monday to assess and review during our spelling lesson.
