Uniform

- We would ask that parents read with their child for 15 minutes each night and ask questions based upon the text once completed. We use be assessing the children's reading ability using the APP Accelerated reader this week.
- Homework will be send out every Friday and is should be returned to school by Tuesday.
- Spellings will be sent home on Monday and they will do spelling activities the following Monday. New spellings will be put on the Spelling Shed APP.
- Please support your child in teaching them how to tell the time.
- It is a national expectation that children fluently know up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4. Please support your child in regularly practicing these. The children will receive a TT Rockstars App login in the next two weeks.

- Children should be in school everyday
- If they are unwell a message should be made to the school office via phone
- Mr Brooks or Mrs Lamb will contact you if they require further information
- Our school target is 98%+
