Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

- Come and See- Beginnings, Signs and Symbols.
- English- A River (circular narrative and letter writing), The Night Gardener (setting narrative and diary entry).
- Maths- Number, focusing on place value in 2 digit numbers, representing numbers, comparing and ordering numbers, counting, and addition and subtraction facts to 10, 20 and 100.
- Science- Animals including humans and Living things and their habitats.
- PE- Tennis, Fitness, Dance and Gymnastics.
- History- Sudley House and its occupants.
- Geography- What is exciting about Mossley Hill?
- Computing- What is a computer? and Algorithms and debugging.
- Art and Design- Drawing: Telling a story.
- Design Technology- Textiles.
- PSHE- Being me in my world and Celebrating differences.
- Music Hands, feet, heart (South African music), Ho ho ho (Christmas songs).

All Aboard Phonics

- We will continue to embed and consolidate the phonics taught in Year 1, and will be covering phase 5 units 1-3.
- Unit 1- New graphemes
- Unit 2- Reading focus (alternative phonemes)
- Unit 3- Spelling focus (alternative graphemes)

► Tricky words will continue to be practised weekly - the, to, and, I, go, no, he, she, we, me, be, was, my, you, they, all, are, said, so, have, like, some, come, were, there, little, one, do, when, out, what, here, says, love, Mr, Mrs, Ms, their, people, oh, there, looked, asked, called, could, should, would.

Uniform

- To be worn on non PE days (currently Monday, Tuesday, Friday).
- Grey shorts or long trousers (Boys)
- Grey skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or long trousers (Girls)
- White shirt with school tie
- School jumper or cardigan (Knitted only) with school logo embroidered
- Grey socks or tights
- Black shoes (not trainers)
- During the summer term, girls may wear a yellow and white check summer dress.
- During the summer term, boys may wear a white polo shirt with the school logo instead of shirt and tie.
- Please ensure all uniform is clearly labelled.

Class dojos

- Children will collect dojos for:
- Good work
- Good answers/confidence in attempting work.
- Good behavior
- Acts of kindness.
- At the end of the week the top 5 dojo earners will be allowed to visit the dojo shop. The children will be allowed to select a prize in returns for their dojos.
- Every child will visit the dojo shop every half term at least once.

Homework, PE Days, Reading

- Children should attend school in their full PE kit on: Wednesday and Thursdays.
- We would ask that parents read with their child for 15 minutes each night and ask questions based upon the text once completed. Please ensure reading books are in school everyday. Books will be changed weekly.
- Homework will be sent out each Friday and is should be retuned to school by the following Friday. Children will receive points for completing their homework.
- Spellings will be sent as part of homework. Children will not be tested on them, but we will complete spelling application activities in class.
- Please support your child in practising letter formation.
- It is a national expectation that children fluently count forwards and backwards up to 100 in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s, and 10s by the end of Year 2. Please support your child in regularly practicing these.

Attendance

- Children should be in school everyday
- If they are unwell a message should be made to the school office via phone
- Mr Brooks or Mrs Lamb will contact you if they require further information
- Our school target is 98%+
- Holidays will not be authorised and may result in a fixed note penalty charge
- Appointments should be made outside of school time, however when this is not possible children should come into school to receive their attendance mark and then go to their appointment. If this is in the morning they should then return to school for their afternoon mark.
