Daily Routine

We start each day with a morning activity, for Autumn term we are focusing on letter and number formation. We also focus on sentence accuracy in English and completing Maths basic skills questions.

Daily Phonics, Maths and English.

Each day children have two break times, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

In the afternoon, Children also have fruit (which is provided by the school).







Statutory Assessment - Phonics Screening Check

W.C 10th June 2024

The Phonics Screening Check is an assessment to check a child's ability to read words using phonics rules. This is the school's first formal way of checking your child's phonics progress and helps the school show the overall progress of children in Year 1. It also helps highlight if any extra support needs to be given.





Uniform

- Grey shorts or long trousers (Boys)
- Grey skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or long trousers (Girls)
- White shirt with school tie
- School jumper or cardigan (Knitted only) with school logo embroidered
- Grey socks or tights
- Black shoes (not trainers)
- During the summer term, girls may wear a yellow and white check summer dress.
- During the summer term, boys may wear a white polo shirt with the school logo instead of shirt and tie.

Homework, PE Days, Reading

- Children should attend school in their full PE kit on: Mondays and Tuesdays.
- We would ask that parents read with their child for 15 minutes each night and ask questions based upon the text once completed.
- Please ensure the reading journal has been signed when your child has read. We can then issue your child with a new reading book.
- It is essential for children to read each day, enjoying their school reading books and other books of their choice. Reading books need to be brought into school every day, with a new book issued every Friday.
- Homework will be send out each Friday and should be retuned to school by the following Friday.
- Please support you child in teaching them how to tell the time. This will be taught in Spring 2 (to the hour and half past the hour).

Attendance

- Children should be in school everyday
- If they are unwell a message should be made to the school office via phone
- Mr Brooks or Mrs Lamb will contact you if they require further information
- Our school target is 98%+
- Holidays will not be authorised and may result in a fixed note penalty charge
- Appointments should be made outside of school time, however when this is not possible children should come into school to receive their attendance mark and then go to their appointment. If this is in the morning they should then return to school for their afternoon mark.
