| 1 | Who can help us online? | <p>This lesson covers 'Self-image and identity' from the Connected World Framework.</p> <p>The children will learn about digital devices, being online, who to ask for help and that sometimes online life can make them feel sad or upset.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I understand something online may upset and know where to find help if anything does, (Self Image)</p> <p>(DL) I can recognise the ways we use technology in our classroom, my home and community.</p> |
| 2 | How can we communicate online? What should we share online? | <p>In this lesson, the children will explore 'Online relationships' and 'Online reputation.</p> <p>The children will learn about how adults use digital devices and apps to communicate. They will explore personal information and sharing information online. They will use a device to send a digital message.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I can communicate politely via the internet. (Online Relationships)</p> <p>(DL) I understand that once something is posted you lose control if it. (Online Reputation)</p> <p>(DL) I can explain what personal information is and give examples of it. (Privacy and Security)</p> |
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| 3 | What is online bullying, and how should we deal with it? | <p>In this lesson, we will be discussing 'Online bullying' and being nice to each other, showing respect, what online bullying is and how to deal with it.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I understand something online may upset and know where to find help if anything does, (Self Image)</p> |
| 4 | How should I behave online? | <p>In this lesson, we will discuss 'Health, well-being and lifestyle' and develop some simple online safe rules and then record a short video clip.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I know the rules of using technology at home or in school. (Health well being)</p> <p>(DL) I can describe how to behave online in ways that do not upset others and can give examples.</p> |
| 5 | What information should not be shared online? | <p>The children will discuss 'Privacy and Security'. In this lesson, we will look at stranger danger, asking for help, revisit personal information and create an avatar and secure passwords.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I can explain what personal information is and give examples of it.</p> |
| 6 | Can you find information online? Who owns the information online? | <p>The children will discuss 'Managing online information' and 'Copyright and ownership'.</p> <p>They children will go online, use a search engine to find images and insert them into a digital document.</p> <p>The children will open and edit their pupil journal.</p> | <p>(DL) I am aware that content online is owned by the person that created it.</p> <p>(DL) I can use a search engine. (Online Bullying)</p> |
