2	How can you build positive online relationships and be a good digital citizen?	 Watch Jigsaw Video <u>Jigsaw</u> Class discussion, Becky's mistakes. Complete challenges 4, 5 & 6 Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can describe ways people who have similar likes and interests can get together online. (DL) I can give example of technology specific forms of communications (e.g. emojis, acronyms, text speak). (DL) I can explain some risks of communicating online with other I don't know well. (DL) I can explain why I should be careful who I trust online and what information I can trust them with. (DL) I can explain how my and other people's feelings can be hurt by what is said or written online. (DL) I can explain why I can take back my trust in someone or something if I feel nervous, uncomfortable or worried. (DL) I can explain what it means to know someone; online and why this might be different from knowing someone in real life. (DL) I can explain why this is different from 'like someone online'.
3	How can I create a positive online reputation?	 Class discussion sharing information online. Complete challenge 7. Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can search for information about myself online. (DL) I can recognise I need to be careful before I share anything about myself or others online. (DL) I know who I should ask if I am not sure if I should put something online.
4	What is online bullying and what can I do about it?	 Class discussion, Online bullying. Watch <u>Hero - Online Bullying</u> Complete challenge 8 Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can explain what bullying is and can describe how people may bully others. (DL) I can describe rules about how to behave online and how I follow them.

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5	Do you really know how to use the internet?	 Complete challenge 9. Accurate searching. Class discussion auto predict. Complete challenge 10. Watch the video <u>Real or Fake</u> Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can use key phrases in search engines. (DL) I can explain what autocomplete is and how to choose the best suggestion. (DL) I can explain how the internet can be used to buy and sell things. (DL) I can explain the difference between a belief, an opinion and a fact.
6	Can technology impact on your health?	 Class discussion can you spend too much time online? Complete challenge 11 and discuss answers as a class. Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	(DL) I can explain why spending too much time using technology can sometimes have a negative impact on me; I can give some examples of activities where it is easy to spend a lot of time engaged (e.g. games, films, videos).
7	How secure are you with your online information and accounts?	 Complete challenges 12 & 13 Self assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can give reasons why I should only share information with people I choose to and I can trust. I can explain that if I am not sure or I feel pressured, I should ask a trusted adult. (DL) I understand and can give reasons why passwords are important. (DL) I can describe simple strategies for creating and keeping passwords private. (DL) I can describe how connected devices can collect and share my information with others.
8	Who owns the information on the internet?	 Class Discussion about who owns online content. Watch <u>What is copyright?</u> Video. Self Assessment and computing vocabulary. 	 (DL) I can explain why copying someone else's work from the internet without permission can cause problems. (DL) I can give examples of what those problems might be.
