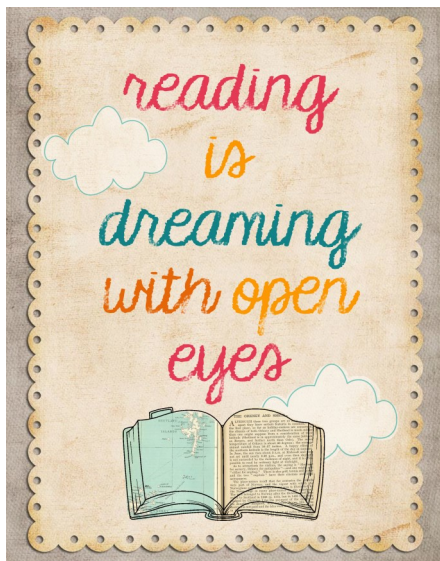


Attendance

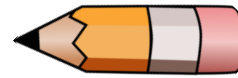
Congratulations to Reception who are this week's attendance champions with 98%. Well done children, we are all extremely proud of you.

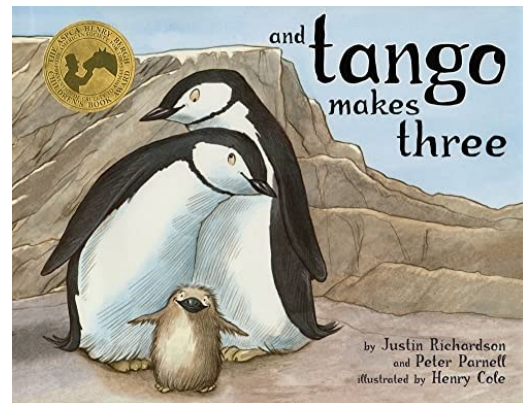


Recommended Reads
