

Click2Teach Medium Term Plan: Stage 1 Summer 1 Spanish



In this module:

This half term the children will be introduced to our Hungry Giant story, and learning how to ask politely for something. The children will firstly learn the nouns for fruits and vegetables and revisit numbers with plural fruit and veg nouns. The unit goes on to introduce the polite request and the story of the Hungry Giant which includes an impolite giant (an opportunity for the children to correct using the polite request) and finally some sentence construction.

Through a story, games and independent tasks, Stage 1 learners will explore the following content, topics and language:

1) Hungry Giant

- Nouns for fruits and vegetables
- Numbers to 15 and plural nouns
- Polite request – asking for something using the structure 'I would like... please'
- Story of Hungry Giant
- Board game to practise polite request and fruit and veg nouns
- Sentence construction (polite request)

Learning Objective for each lesson:

- 1) I can understand and say fruit and vegetable nouns
- 2) I can count fruits and vegetables in Spanish
- 3) I can understand and enjoy a story about fruits and vegetables
- 4) I can ask politely for a fruit or vegetables
- 5) I can remember fruit and veg nouns and play a board game
- 6) I can write a sentence using a model
