

Click2Teach Medium Term Plan: Stage 3 Summer 2 Spanish



In this module:

This half term is all about going to the seaside. The children will start by learning about beaches in Spain and items they might take to the seaside. They will then start creating descriptive sentences about the seaside, use persuasive sentences about visiting the seaside to create and perform an advert and build up to creating extended sentences using the language they have learnt plus conjunctions to extend.

The children will go on to find out interesting facts about the seaside in a reading detectives lesson.

Finally, in the final lesson for Summer 2, the children will have an opportunity to use their language detective skills to experience a lesson learning another language! In Stage 3 the children will try a lesson of French.

Going to the seaside

- Find out more about beaches in Spain
- Learn nouns for items to take to the beach
- Write sentences related to the seaside
- Use persuasive sentences to create and perform an advert about the seaside
- Create extended sentences about the seaside using conjunctions
- Reading detectives lesson – unpick world record facts related to the seaside
- Experience a lesson in another language: French!

- 2) I can recall some sentence starters and use them to talk about the seaside
- 3) I can understand and say persuasive sentences about visiting the seaside

- 6) I can apply my language detective skills to learn another language
