

Click2Teach Medium Term Plan: Stage 4 Autumn 2 Spanish



In this module:

During this half term the children will learn the nouns for rooms in a house and the nouns for furniture in the style of artist Piet Mondrian. The children will prepare descriptive sentences to sell a house and write their own spooky story after following a story about a haunted house. The children will have the opportunity to see and pronounce the names of some authentic Spanish castles, explore new nouns associated with castles and play a game of 'Escape from the castle'. As a festive lesson, the children will explore where is the Elf on the Shelf (or the Christmas Elf) and prepositions.

Through games, native speaker clips and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

2a - Spooky House/Space House

- Learn nouns for rooms in a house
- Learn nouns for furniture in the house
- Read, say and write descriptive sentences
- Follow a story about a haunted house then write own spooky house story
- Explore Spanish castles and new nouns associated with castles
- Play game using new language

2b – The Christmas Elf

- Revisit personal information
- Explore prepositions as you answer: Where is the elf?

Learning Objective for each lesson:

- 1) I can understand and say some nouns for rooms in a house
- 2) I can read and pronounce objects in the house
- 3) I can use adjectives to describe rooms in the house
- 4) I can say and write a series of sentences to make a story
- 5) I can understand and use new nouns
- 6) I can use prepositions to say where things are
