Reception and Year 6 have been very excited at the arrival of six special chicks this week. A special thank you to the Schroder family for sourcing the eggs and incubator for school.




# **Attendance**

Each week we will be celebrating the child in each class who has made a huge effort or improvement with their presentation. They will be awarded a special pencil in assembly. Our winners for this week are:


