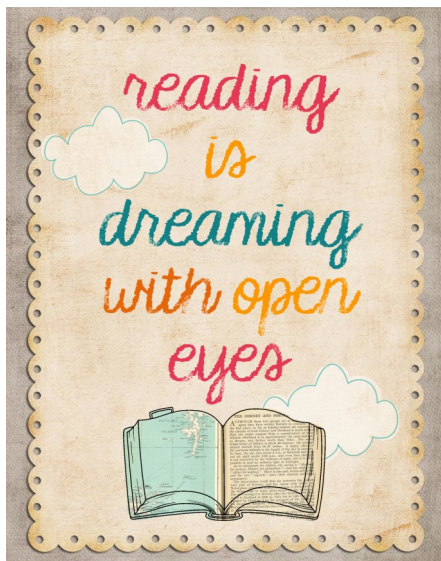


Attendance
