### Statutory Assessment Update:

Reception GLD-80% of the children achieved a Good Level of Development compared to the provisional national average of 68%.

Phonics Screening Check-93% of the children achieved the expected standard compared to the provisional national average of 80%. 97% of our Year 2 cohort have passed the Phonics Screening Check.
