#### What is Phonics?













Through phonics children are taught how to:


- recognise the sounds that each individual letter makes
- identify the sounds that different combinations of letters make such as 'sh' or 'oo'; and
- blend these sounds together from left to right to make a word.


















## J. Key Phonics Terms J.



Grapheme	A letter or group of letters representing a single phoneme.	S
Phoneme	The smallest unit of sound in a word that changes the meaning of the word when it is changed.	
Digraph	A grapheme made up of two letters.	sea
Trigraph	A grapheme made up of three letters.	sigh
Split Digraph	A grapheme with two letters that has another grapheme between them.	same

## J. Key Phonics Terms L.



Decoding	The translation of the graphemes in a word into phonemes.	S
Blending	The blending of phonemes to voice a word.	"/s/ /a/ /t/ sat!"
Segmenting	The division of a word into individual phonemes.	"Sat /s/ /a/ /t/."
Sounding out	The voicing of the individual phonemes in a word.	"Isl lal ltl."








## Tricky Words





- <u>Tricky words</u> are words that cannot be easily decoded using common phonetic rules.
- These words may have unusual spellings, silent letters, or irregular pronunciations that don't match their written form.

 They support reading fluency which will also aid comprehension.




## Year 1 - Phonics Screening Check



The purpose of the phonics screening check is to confirm that all children have learned phonic decoding to an age-appropriate standard.


## Phonics Screening Check



- The Phonics Screening Check contains 40 words divided into two sections of 20 words.
- Both sections contain a mixture of real words and pseudo-words.

#### Pseudo-words

- All pseudo-words in the check are accompanied by a picture of an imaginary creature.
- This ensures that they are not trying to match the pseudo-word to a word in their vocabulary.

- Test repeated in June of Year 2 if pass mark not reached












#### Year 1 example
