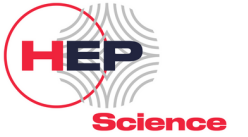

Lesson 2	What Happens in Spring?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Spot signs of spring - Describe spring weather - Talk about new life in spring 	Observing closely; identifying and classifying spring characteristics; recording data	1 class mystery box with: 1 blossom twig, 1 spring flower sample, 1 raindrop or umbrella prop, , 30 spring word bank worksheets, 6 sets of coloured pencils
Lesson 3	What Happens in Summer?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observe summer weather - Describe temperature and day length - Spot signs of summer 	Performing simple tests; gathering and recording data; identifying and classifying	1 class mystery box with: 1 sunshine symbol, 1 thermometer, 1 pair of sunglasses, 1 large daylight calendar, 30 "How Day Length Changes" worksheets
Lesson 4	What Happens in Autumn?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observe autumn weather - Describe seasonal changes - Spot autumn signs 	Observing closely; identifying and classifying; recording data about seasonal changes	1 class mystery box with: 1 autumn leaf, 1 windy or cloudy weather symbol6 sets of autumn picture cards, 30 weather recording sheets, 6 sets of animal sorting cards, 6 sets of leaf specimens
Lesson 5	What Happens in Winter?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Spot winter signs - Describe winter weather - Talk about animals and trees 	Observing and recording findings; performing simple tests; classifying winter features	1 class mystery box with: 1 frost or ice symbol, 1 toy hibernating animal, 6 sets of winter weather symbols, 6 sets of bare tree images, 6 sets of animal sorting cards, 30 "My Hibernation Den" worksheet materials
Lesson 6	What Happens in a Year?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Talk about how seasons change - Spot patterns across the year - Compare seasonal changes 	Using observations to suggest answers; gathering and recording data; comparing features	1 class mystery box with: 1 pair of sunglasses, 1 paper snowflake, 1 artificial flower, 1 coloured leaf, 1 bird's nest, 1 large seasons circle display, Art materials: 30 sheets of coloured paper, 6 sets of markers, 6 scissors, 6 glue sticks, 6 sheets of symbol stickers, 6 season summary card sets, 30 "My Favourite Season" worksheets, 1 class camera
